The Father said no Noah: 'I can no longer tolerate these children who I have created; they are so filled with evil in these times...' and after the Great Flood, God made a Covenant with Noah and we see it quite often... that Covenant which reminds us of the presence of God, His promise and more properly, which we have forgotten the Covenant that God made, every time we see a rainbow... that is the Covenant of God with man.

Again, it happened with Moses when God explained to him: 'I want every man, every family, all that you have, all that you are... consecrated to Me, you are my children... I want you to create a Covenant with Me; a pact... between a Father and his child, between a Father and the nation.

And Moses taught them... these 600 thousand men, and then they to their families. And when every man was consecrated, when the Covenant with God was created He moved them and soon the people began to see the promise of God.

He fed them when they ran out of food and every night like a rainbow, but every night, there was a large flame next to the Tent of the Ark of the Covenant and that flame said to the people: 'I am Here, I exist and I love you, I am your Father and I have created this Covenant with you' and the flame was next to the Tent of the Ark of the Covenant to remind them of this Covenant.

The shoes on their feet never wore out for forty years, the clothes on their back never wore out in forty years, the Promise of a Father to His child.: 'Child, I shall protect you, I shall love you, put your faith and trust in Me... create a Covenant with Me and be bound by it and you shall have peace'.

2 Chronicles Chapter 7, God speaks to Salomon and He says to him: 'Tell the children who bear My Name, that if they should turn from their wicked ways, if they should come back to Me in all things, My Laws and Commandments, I shall save them, I shall cleanse them, I shall restore them and I shall restore their nation.'

The Promise of God... He has never gone back on a promise; but in these times, we have lost the understanding of Consecration and creating a Covenant with God. We no longer understand it... Consecration is the understanding that you are a child of God; it is giving to God all that you are, all that you have for His Love and His Protection, through the intercession of the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart.

A grace comes through consecration and that grace is the grace of conversion... the Greeks call it Metanoia, a spiritual awakening; to understand who you are, that you are a son of God, a daughter of God... that we are just here just for a very short period of time to learn; and then to accept what you want for Eternity... that which you cannot see, but that which you know in your soul exists... you want it more than the things that you can see, because you understand that those things are temporary... you are not here for these things, you are here to learn through your free will and through that, there will come a moment in time, when you will understand the meaning of life: 'To love'.
