Many of you are crying... Why? It was just a few minutes of music. What would have touched your hearts so deeply that would cause many of you tonight to weep? The answer: `You are children of God, not children of the world`.

When you come into the presence of anything of God, your hearts open and that light of God comes in and reminds you of the love of God. That God exists, and that He loves you... you are His child.

Sadly, in the world in these times, many of us are serving two masters and we are forgetting who we are and we are losing our identity. Many of us are always in the middle, never wanting to finally declare ourselves. And the world in these times has a very powerful influence over each of us; so much so that many of us are running the risk of being lukewarm, which is a very dangerous place to be.

Our Lord speaks to us from the Gospel, He says to us: `For each of you who is lukewarm, at the end of time, to each of you who is lukewarm, I will spit you from my mouth`. It's very serious.

We run the risk of committing the only sin, which is unforgivable, the sin of blasphemy; when we blaspheme against the Spirit of God that resides in each of us, where we reject our own identity. And in these times, many; many of us are rejecting who we are, losing our identity.



We are also losing common sense and common sense helps us to dictate reality. But many people in the world today, have lost their reality.

I live in Europe and in Europe many people are declaring themselves secular; secular simply means to exist without God. And I ask you: How is it possible that you and I could have come so far away from the light of God? People just like us, that we think there can be a future without God, that we think we can live under our own providence; but all through Europe and now coming into this country, this belief is taking hold and we are abandoning God, many, many of us.

it's not uncommon to see in London this double decker red buses with signs on the sides that say: `God is dead`. Our churches are empty, in some of the major places in London. at a daily Mass, the number of people here tonight would be considered a very large crowd.

We are closing churches. Parish by parish, we do not have enough priests, our seminaries are almost empty. We are importing priests from Africa, who barely speak English just to keep the mass schedule. Our families are also under this continuing threat, our families are dissolving. We are approaching one of every two marriages ending in separation or divorce and our children are suffering because of it.

We are living in a world whose message is that we can do whatever we want, whenever we want, with whomever we want, we have no one to answer to and our children are suffering terribly.

In Europe, we have a crisis among our young people. We are suffering the highest rate of teenage suicide ever recorded; because our children have no hope... because they do not know about God. We stopped being examples of people of God, we don't pray in our homes as families anymore and our children are not being taught about God.

We are removing the name of God from our Constitution; we are removing the Commandments of God from our Laws; and this wind that is blowing in this direction, is starting to affect these lands as well. This movement towards absolute freedom of the individual is taking hold here, and that freedom includes from God. We do not want responsibility anymore.

We are having less and less children, less and less marriages, and in Europe, we are leading single lives, everything is about `me`. Self-gratification, selfishness, self-centeredness and this way of life is creating terrible problems. We are having less than two children per family while other faiths are having over six, putting into question whether in twenty or thirty years from now, Europe will still be a Christian Continent.

Here in this country, you have heard a lot about religious freedom, you are hearing the phrase `conscience of faith`. You are being told that conscience of faith is no longer important; it doesn't matter what you believe, it only matters what you are being told. And the few are controlling the many; the few that have been deceived, are controlling the many who are silent. In these times, all over the world the children of God sit silently, as if we are waiting for something, we are waiting for someone to come along and fix all of these problems; and all the time we do this, we contribute to the overall apathy and complacency that has come over the world.



And in the world today, there is a mountain which is growing; it is a mountain of wickedness and corruption and in that, the enemy of God laughs and Our Lord is crying, He is crying... He is saying to us: `Children, you don't read anymore, you don't read the Word of God anymore; you say you have no time. Cause if you read the word of God, you would know.

Oh, you of little faith, if only one of you had the faith of a tiny little mustard seed... and that is the problem in these times, we are losing the understanding of who we are, and because of it, we are serving two masters. But the Bible tells us clearly that we cannot, it doesn't work.

Each one of us is here for a very short period of time, to learn the meaning of life, to understand the gift of life. We have a responsibility to God for this gift of our lives, we have a responsibility to understand who we are and to go in search of that meaning.

In every life, there comes a moment in time when each one of us understands there is something greater than ourselves; and by the grace of God, we should go in search of that, search for the meaning of life. When Our Lord was asked: `Lord, what is the most important thing?` Jesus goes right back to the beginning, He goes right back to the Ten Commandments.

Many people do not understand the Ten Commandments. Why they were given on two tablets of stone and why they were given 3 Commandments on one and seven on the other? The reason: they are a clear pathway into the heart of God. The first Tablet of stone teaches us how to love God, the Second tablet teaches us how to love one another.

That was the answer of Our Lord, the most important thing is to love God with all of your heart, with all of your soul, with all of your mind, because then and only then can we ever understand how to love one another, the citizenship of eternity.

So, what is the answer? What is the solution? For that we go back in time, we go back to the time of Moses, and we understand why God commanded Moses to spend time with Him on the top of Mount Sinai; and there, God instructed Moses... instructed him to tell the six hundred thousand men at that time, how to prepare themselves for this journey. This journey from a cursed land into a new life, the Promised Land.

He told them that they would give unto Him all that they were, all that they had and God would give them His protection and His love. That they were the chosen children of God for those times, and the men were to instruct their families, and to prepare their families to consecrate themselves; and there is the beginning of what we turn to in this Church, when there are times of great crisis: Consecration.

Consecration then forms a Covenant with God, and Moses instructed them and they prepared themselves and they all consecrated themselves to God. God kept his word as they moved out into this very long time in the desert. Every morning and every evening He fed them. When they went to sleep at night, they saw the presence of God, in the form of a tongue of flame in front of the Tent of Ark of the Covenant.



From the chronicles of those times, we also understand something else, we understand the love of God. The shoes on their feet, never wore out. The clothes on their back, never wore out... When God promised to take care of them, to protect them, He did so in all things.

And in these times, once again, we are at the time in the history of mankind, where we turn to God in this way. The Catholic children of the world with the advent of Our Lord Jesus, are the chosen children of God for these times; and we are to consecrate ourselves to the love and the protection of God in these times.

In these times consecration simply means `a change´ and it carries with it an `invisible grace´, the grace of conversion. For every person that enters the House of God, that attends a Mass of Consecration, they then have a desire in their heart. That is the only prerequisite, that is the only thing, which is necessary, the desire in your heart.

God gives this free gift, that every day, day by day, one day at a time, we begin to see things that we never saw before and were always right in front of us; and we begin to realize that there is a war which is raging outside, the war of good against evil. But to see that war and understand it, we must be who we are, not what we have become: children of the flesh.

A child of the flesh is not going to see that war until it´s too late, because it is a spiritual war. Each of us needs a metanoia. Metanoia simply means a spiritual awakening... because we are asleep... The world is putting us into a deep hypnotic sleep. Our time has been stolen from us in these times.

Personal change is the only way forward in these times. I am a child of God and I am not going to offend God today, because we are always offending God through the same sins over and over. I´m not going to offend God today; I will make up my mind and I will not sin against God today.

I´m tired of feeling guilty, I´m tired of being afraid, I´m tired of being silent. Being afraid to stand up in the name of God, no longer I am going to allow those to tell me what I know in my soul is wrong, is right. Because in these times, like the technology, there is a purposeful move to remove the name of Father from our memory, from our families; because men are no longer men in their families, they are no longer playing the role they are meant to play and the word father is taking a different dimension.

We are allowing the world to remove the word `father´ from the priesthood. We do not respect the priest as we should.

We are allowing the world to remove the name `Father´ from God Himself. We are no longer connected to God as our Father, generally speaking, because we no longer talk to God as our Father. We no longer include Him in everything we do each day. And how can we love God, if we don´t even know Him? How can you trust God, when you have no relationship with Him? We must change this immediately. We must restore that child of God in each of us.

We must restore the name of Father in our hearts. And unless God is at the center of our daily lives, as our Father, we will never understand the gift of life, the gift of our faith and one another, unless it is through the love of God.



The First Commandment is not even being respected anymore in this world. The love of God... it's up to each one of us and that is this Mission.

Consecration, Metanoia, learning to reconnect with your Father and learning through good works, to serve and to love each other. Together, we can change things, in union with the Church; the laity and the priesthood, we can change... praying the same prayer, for the same intention, working together, in unity... all the groups, all working together, we can change anything...
